Programme Highlights : Hong Kong is a well-developed place with one of the most reliability and wide coverage of infra-structural provisions throughout the City, including water supply, drainage disposal, gas, power, tel-com and etc. We can find easily on having utilities availability when doing a new development design and planning. Even the location is offset from urban area, utilities is always not a matter or difficulty to most of new building development.

However, in some really remote / suburb location or other region of the World, there is without completed or insufficient town planning; the developer / owner needs to take care on how to have clean potable water supply, sewage disposal and catchment of rainfall, etc., which many engineers / construction parties in HK general projects may not have change to think about it.
